An extraordinary Parts Advisor Apprentice

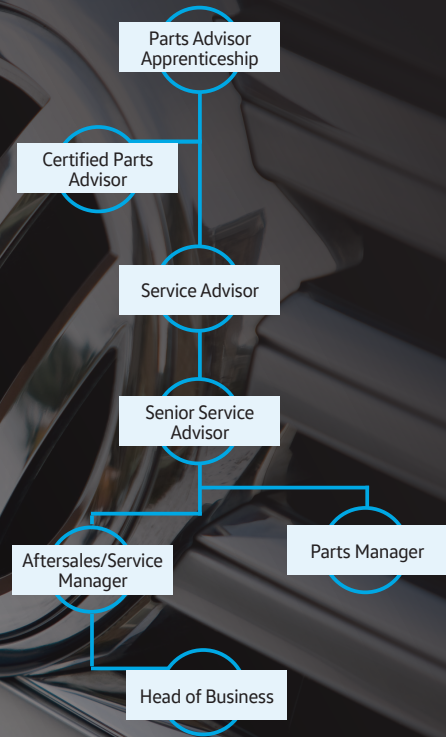
