What does a Service Technician do?

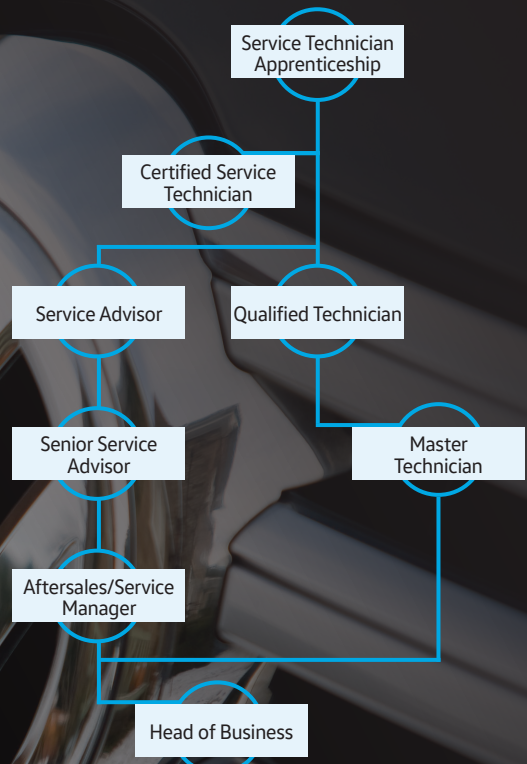
