An extraordinary Service Advisor Apprentice

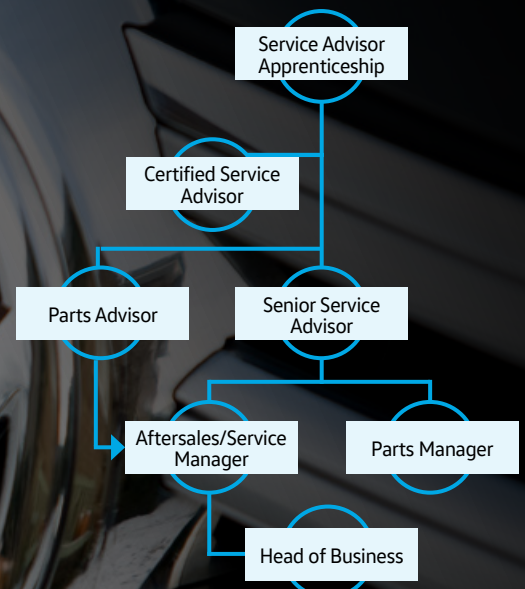
